# **St Joe Community Foundation Grant for Safe Sleep Initiative**



This year the Coalition was a grateful recipient of a St. Joe Community Foundation Grant. The grant is providing safe sleep Pack and Plays and educational awareness to the first responders/fire departments throughout the Bay County area.

In 2023 there were five preventable infant demises in Bay County due to unsafe sleep practices by caregivers. The goal of the grant is to provide direct on-site training and awareness to first responders regarding safe sleep practices and education.

Firemen/first responders are already providing informal education to the community they serve. This safe sleep awareness training will give them a format to start a conversation with the families about the importance of keeping their infants safe while sleeping.
